This training is brought to you by the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Office of School Safety. This is intended as an overview of the standard process for partners within our community, including businesses, faith based communities and public safety.

Course Description: The Office of School Safety (OSS) will present a model of comprehensive school safety and introduce SRP and SRM to community members. These procedures are practical, action based, responses given to any situation within a school community. This could also be very applicable to businesses and congregations for reunification of staff and parishioners in times of emergency. The six specific actions performed after an incident include Hold, Secure, Lockdown, Evacuate, Shelter, and Reunify. The SRM is utilized to reunite students with parents and guardians after an emergency or crisis. This 2-hour training is free.

Target Audience: Community Members interested in school safety, how to support reunification for schools and reunifying your workplace and group environments.
