## About Care Trak:



A Care Trak wristband and transmitter.

Care Trak is an organization serving Sheriff, Police, Fire, and EMS agencies nationwide.

Participants are fitted with a personalized Care Trak wristband. This

unique wristband is a battery-operated transmitter that emits an automatic tracking signal every second, 24 hours a day. Using specialized equipment, this signal can be tracked by our trained personnel.

Caregivers need to test the transmitter twice daily and change the battery every 60 days.

Care Trak of Dane County emphasizes relationships between law enforcement and the people who may wander before the need may arise for a rescue.

## Who Qualifies for Care Trak?

If you care for a loved one who has a history of wandering due to a disorder such as Dementia, Down Syndrome, or Autism, this program is for you.

Trained Dane County Sheriff's Deputies will come to your home and fit the participant with a transmitter. That transmitter can be tracked if the client becomes lost or missing.

Care Trak cannot predict or report that the participant has wandered off. Care Trak is activated by a caregiver calling 911.

Care Trak does not replace the need for constant supervised care of the participant.

Participant must not be driving anymore or allowed to be by themselves at home or in the community.

Participants must live in Dane County. Caregivers are responsible for following the conditions set by Care Trak and The Dane County Sheriff's Office.
